1.2 Audience

The audience for this document is certified partners selling and implementing as well as customers who have bought the solution.

1.3 Product release information

Project Control Suite 10.0.43.63 for Dynamics 365 Finance and Dynamics 365 Supply Chain Management (10.0) is built upon D365 version 10.0.43. Since Microsoft maintains a no breaking changes policy, the fact that this release is built on this version means that it can be applied to an environment running on D365 version 10.0.40 or any later version and the application should compile without any issues. However, as we have only functionally validated this version against D365

version 10.0.43, we recommend applying our STAEDEAN product release on that MS version as well. If you deviate from this (and thus apply the release to a different version), we recommend performing a more thorough round of testing before applying the release to a production environment.

STAEDEAN cannot be obliged to provide Hotfixes if Client has not deployed the latest Release or the Release second to the latest Release and/or is not using a supported version of Microsoft Dynamics.

To ensure our customers can fully leverage the latest enhancements, features, and quality improvements, we are committed to providing increased support by keeping them updated with the most recent releases. Our data indicates that customers on the latest version experience fewer issues and requests, demonstrate greater resilience, and effectively enhance their organizational efficiency.

#Note: From D365 7.3, Microsoft has changed the way additional Dimensions are handled. The goal for this move is to enable adding additional Dimensions in the application via code extension instead of over layering. Microsoft has introduced a Dimension framework in 7.3 to enable this, the implementation of this framework is treated as a transition process by Microsoft. Practically this means that any fix from Microsoft that they classify as an extensibility request is only delivered in the latest D365 release and that such fix is not backported.

With the introduction of the Dimension framework in D365 7.3 it has become the VAR's responsibility to implement any specific Dimension (such as the Project dimension) in the framework. To give the VAR a head start, STAEDEAN has created a separate model which can be used as a template by the VAR which implements the Tracking dimension "Project" as the newly introduced InventoryDimension08. As part of this deliverable STAEDEAN will evaluate case by case whether it will honour any requests for fixes which are resulting from Microsoft not backporting fixes as mentioned above. STAEDEAN makes no promises that it can and will fix all bugs that Microsoft does not backport.

In case multiple ISV solutions have been installed which are adding Inventory Dimensions, the VAR needs to decide which dimension to use. STAEDEAN supports the implementation as delivered via the PbmPIMVAR (Project Inventory VAR) model in case another dimension is implemented by the VAR it is the VAR's responsibility to support this.

1.4 PCS Rebranding

We are pleased to announce that **Advance Project Management (APM)** will now be known as **Project Control Suite (PCS)**. This change reflects our enhanced focus on managing and controlling complex project in D365. While the core functionality you rely on remains intact, we have already started to be enhance these areas and our PCS roadmap has expanded to offer even greater value. you'll notice the name **APM** has been replaced with **PCS** in the user interface as well. We're excited about the future of PCS and look forward to supporting your continued success with these improvements.

1.5 Certificate renewal information

As an Independent Software Vendor, we provide you with licenses which can be used to enable/use our solution. These licenses are based on a Microsoft certificate which is part of our solution. This certificate expires every 3 years, this year per 09-06-2023. At that moment it must be renewed, and new licenses need to be installed.

Please make sure you install the latest update before June 9th, as these releases do contain the new certificate. Together with this update, you must install the new license. New licenses will only work together with the new certificate.

In case you get an error message 'license is not valid' during installation, then there is a mismatch between license and software package. After installing the latest update and latest license, please verify by logging into the application and see the respective menus.

Please note that if you try to re-load licenses for standard D365 F&O (e.g., adding more users) before installing the latest version and license, it will cause a re-validation of all ISV licenses, and that will cause the license for the STAEDEAN solution to fail as the underlying certificate is no longer valid. Users can no longer make use of the functionality.

If you have not received the new license deliverable(s), you can obtain the new license(s) from STAEDEAN by sending an email to swdist@staedean.com . Also, do not forget to mention the LCS project name and URL to which the license needs to be added.

After installing the update, the security certificate renewal can be completed in 3 simple steps.

Step 1: Install the update and navigate to the Solution Management Workspace

Step 2: Click the 'Retrieve available licenses' in the action pane.

Important: In this release, Project Control Suite I (PCS I) and Project Control Suite II (PCS II) are only supported with active licenses for both, it is not possible to run Project Control Suite I without the license for Project Control Suite II.

1.8 Upgrade from earlier versions

Upgrade of PCS from PCS for D365 7.3 onwards is supported via the use of the migration process and tooling as required to upgrade from Microsoft Dynamics 365 for Operations.

From 8.1 to 10.0, there are no upgrade scripts required. Please refer installation guide for further information.

1.9 Support for multiple languages

At STAEDEAN, we are constantly working to upgrade our solutions and encourage customers to participate by sharing feedback. We had earlier launched an in-app feedback option in our D365 solutions, where our customers can share their feedback and requests while using our solutions. We did receive multiple requests for translations in other (European) languages. We picked the most requested languages and added it to our roadmap.

From April 2023 release, we do support Advanced maintenance and service in 10 different languages out of the box. The user interface is, as part of the strategy, available in the next languages: English (US), German, French, Spanish, Portuguese, Dutch, Italian, Norwegian, Swedish, Danish.

STAEDEAN is using the Microsoft Dynamics 365 Translation Service for automated translations of user interface elements. In our solutions we use standard labels and new solution specific labels. The standard labels are already provided with translations done by Microsoft. The solution specific labels are now also available to users in more languages.

As we used automated translations and reused existing labels it might be the case that some translations are wrongly translated. With a single translation unit, the AI powered translation service



is not aware if it should be translated as noun or verb. Some words do have multiple meanings, like "application". It could be related to recruitment or a software solution. If you come across such issue, please use the in-app feedback, or create a support case, so we can improve the translations for future releases.

If you are in the need for other languages or your business requires a different term, you can extend the label files with a small development effort.

If you have customizations on the translations in your current environment, check if this is done in a separate extension model and correct extension naming convention. If e.g., the name of the STAEDEAN label file in the English language is TILabel.en-US.label.txt, the new translation in German provided by STAEDEAN will get the file name TILabel.de.label.txt. Ensure your customization will then have a naming convention including the keyword extension. A German extension label file has then the name TILabel_extension.de.label.txt. The extension labels will have priority above the standard provided labels. You can also choose to remove your labels and uptake our new standard translations.

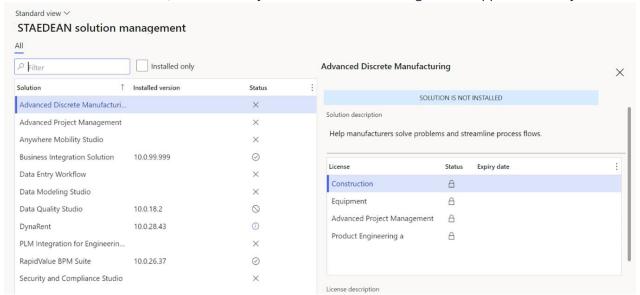
2. New features

2.1 Common features

STAEDEAN is offering various add-on solutions. Some features and technical solutions are common or could be common for all our solutions on the Dynamics 365 Finance and Operations platform. As of November 2022, we will start leveraging a new common library model.

The common library model will be a centralized location where the new common features will be added automatically, and customers do not have to make an additional effort to update the build pipelines after the first enablement of this model.

ISV licensing is technically supported with a code signing certificate. The certificate we must use expires every three years, next up for renewal in 2023. Soon, our solutions will refer to this common model for the code signing certificate, instead of maintaining it separately in all our solutions. Next to technical content, the common library comes with features which are beneficial to our customers. E.g., a solutions Management dashboard gives a clear view of currently installed versions, status of license, option to renew licenses without any downtime, easy access to release notes and documentation, and the ability to leave feedback through the in-app feedback system.

2.2 Feature deprecation effective February 2024

You may have already been informed by Microsoft, that licenses that are generated using the SHA1 algorithm will no longer be supported starting at Microsoft Dynamics 365's F&SCM version 10.0.39. This update is already made available by Microsoft. You can get it from LCS.

As we currently use the SHA1 algorithm for our licenses, there is an action for you to take to ensure you can continue using our services. We introduce the new SHA256 algorithm for our licenses, which will be supported going forward by Microsoft.

What do you need to do before updating to version 10.0.39?

You need to install these licenses based on the SHA256 algorithm.

2.3 New features for this release

- The application was upgraded to support **Microsoft Dynamics 365 Finance & Operations version 10.0.43**. No new functional features were introduced in this release
- Introduced an extensibility point to allow customers or partners to enable progress billing against finalized purchase orders. This supports additional project billing scenarios where contracts require invoicing against locked procurement stages.

3. Known Issues

3.1 Known issues from previous releases.

ID	Title
1	When progress bill is set to OFF the bid rate is not getting calculated correctly for Time and Material project.
2	With progress bill retention and retention tax is calculated at root project. Apply Tax calculation at sub-project level for retentions is not yet supported.
3	Although the WBS Ids are corrected using the new menu item, correct WBS ID for selected projects, there are more permutations to maintain/delete activities under the root node directly.
	Hence, it is a known issue that maintaining tasks under root project can create WBS ID discrepancies
